#### **CMS Arrival Map**

**Homeroom is from 7:52 AM - 8:07 AM**. Once students enter their designated entrance door, see below, students report directly to their homeroom on the first day of school. Lockers will be optional for students in grades 6 - 8.

- **Bus Students:** Students will enter the doors by the tech ed room and pick up a breakfast on the way to homeroom.
- **5th Grade:** enter through the main doors and pick up a breakfast on the way to homeroom.
- **6th Grade:** enter through side cafeteria doors and pick up a breakfast on the way to homeroom.
- **7th Grade:** enter through the below exterior doors pick up a breakfast on the way to homeroom.
- 8th Grade: enter through the doors located by the memory garden and pick up a breakfast on the way to homeroom.

#### **CMS Dismissal Map**

All students will exit through the main entrance of the Middle School and proceed off campus. We will operate on two staggered dismissal times. The dismissal times are as follows:
