- Cleaning, disinfecting, sanitizing, and maintaining healthy facilities

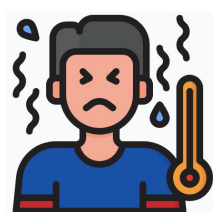

Nurse's Office



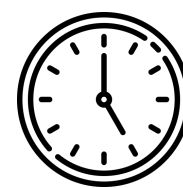
- Stay home if unwell and go home if feeling unwell while at school

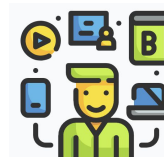

- All students will be provided with a district owned iPad K-12;
- The iPad technology fee is \$10
- Students in grades 9-12 will use [Canvas](#) as their learning management system
- The district will assess students' academic needs through the use of high-quality screeners for students in grades K-4 and high-quality ELA and math diagnostics in grades K through high school. The school district will utilize technology tools to create personalized learning pathways for students.

Lockers & Transitions

- As a mitigation measure, to prevent gathering and congregating in the hallways in between classes, students will not be assigned lockers for the 2021-2022 school year. Class transitions with one-way traffic will continue in 2021-2022 as a mitigation measure.
